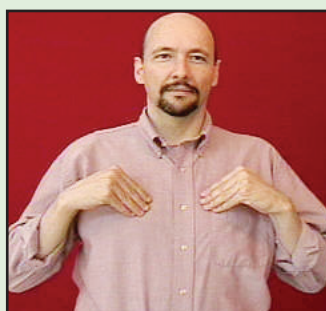
Signing "ACCEPT"
